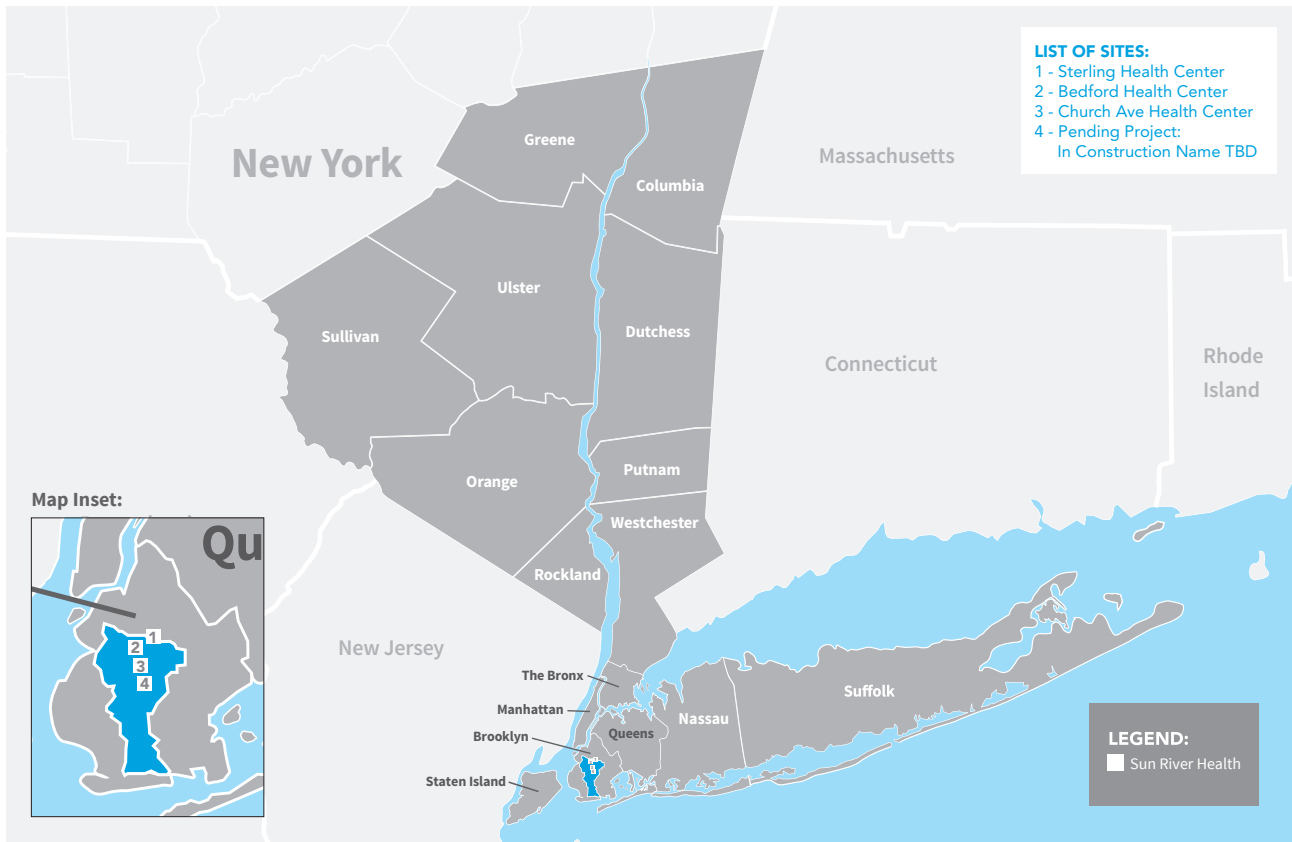

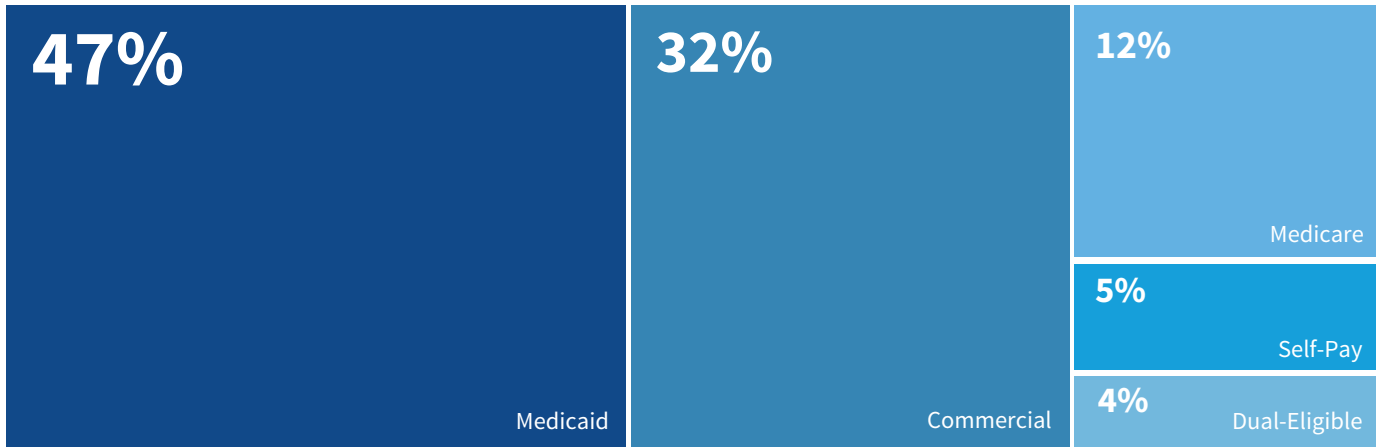

## Achievements

- Our 340b program provide patients with critical medications at low-to-no cost, including HIV medications and Suboxone
- In-house pharmacy at the Sterling, Church Avenue, and Bedford Health Centers
- One of six HIV Undetectables Programs in NYC with 200 patients enrolled, all of whom have achieved over 90% viral load suppression rate
- Expanded Adult Day Health Care program
- Successful TransHealth advocacy and support program offers education and pre/post-operative support for transgender individuals
- Expanded the Article 31 program to link children, adolescents, and families with behavioral health services
- Successful Transitional Care Program, funded by the Robin Hood Program, provides community-based engagement for high-risk patients with HIV, diabetes, or hypertension
- Successful opioid replacement therapy program for opioid use disorder
- Planned expanded access of primary care, dental, behavioral health and substance use services at a new site, estimated third quarter of 2019, including 12 exam rooms, 6 dental operatories, and pharmacy
