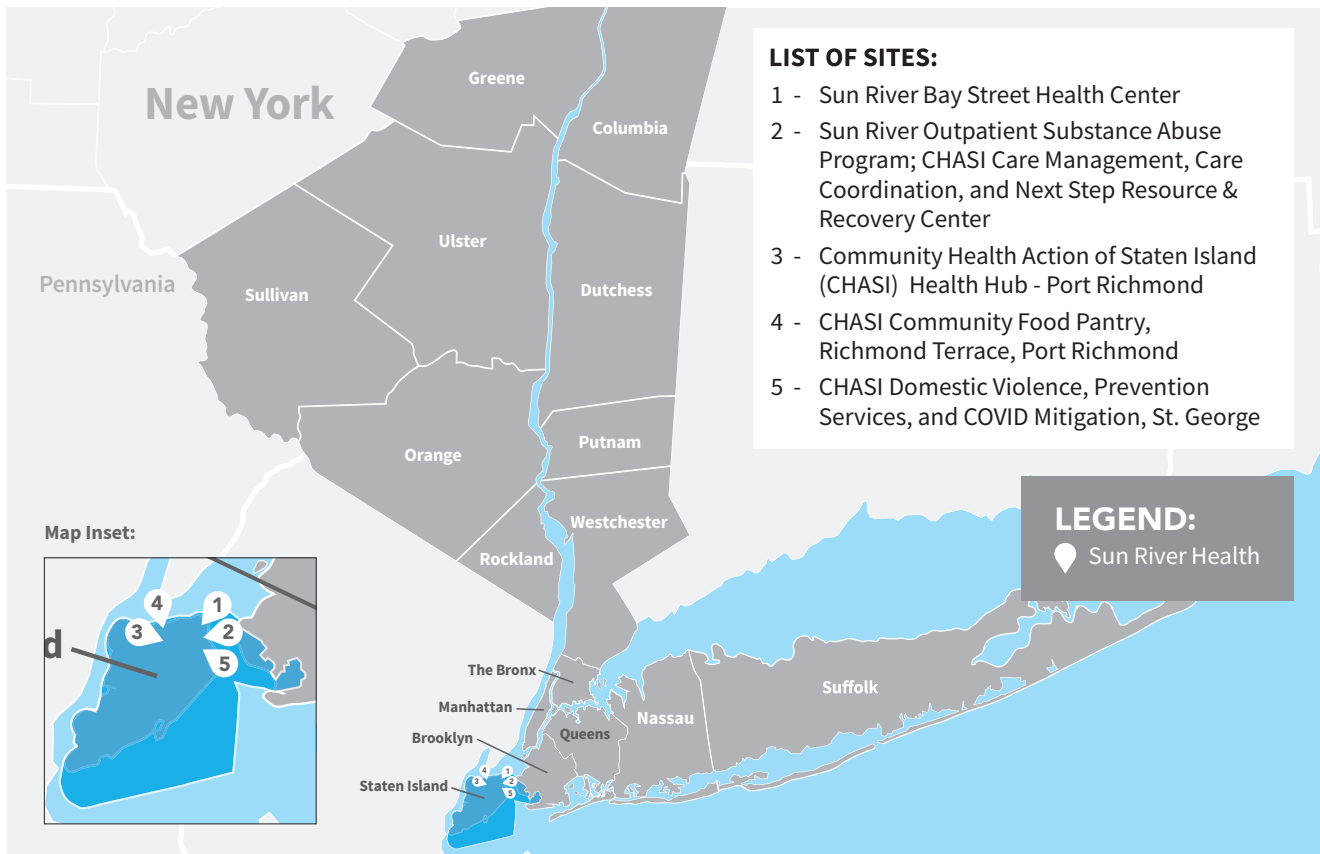

About our Services on Staten Island

Sun River Health operates a **Community Health Center** with primary care, pediatrics, OB/GYN, and dental services in St. George, Staten Island. The health center network also runs an **OASAS-licensed addiction treatment program** from a location across the street, also on Bay Street.

Sun River is the parent company of **Community Health Action of Staten Island (CHASI)**, a community-based nonprofit social services agency that serves thousands of Staten Islanders each year. Founded over thirty years ago as the Staten Island AIDS Task Force, CHASI provides **outreach, education, prevention, and direct support services** for populations most affected by health disparities – the poor and working poor, low-income people with chronic illnesses, people with criminal justice involvement, substance users, domestic violence survivors, people of color, and the LGBTQ community.

CHASI operates a **harm reduction health hub, domestic violence program, 24/7 resource and recovery center, food pantry and mobile food pantry, alternatives to incarceration project, HIV testing, and prevention services**, and is a direct care provider for **NYS Health Home care management**. In 2020, CHASI began work as a community-based service provider connecting communities to COVID-19 testing and information through the Test+Trace program.
