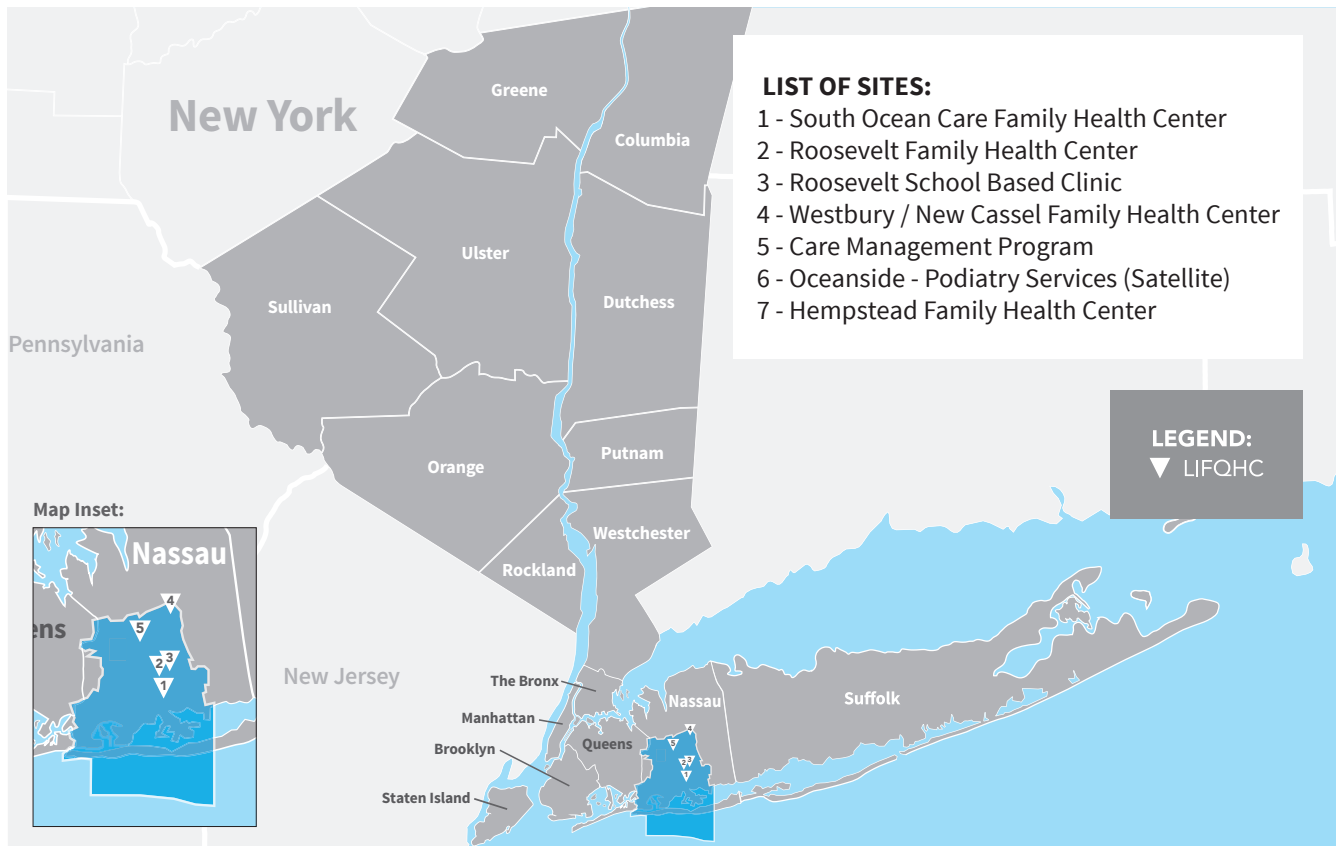

Benefits counseling, care coordination

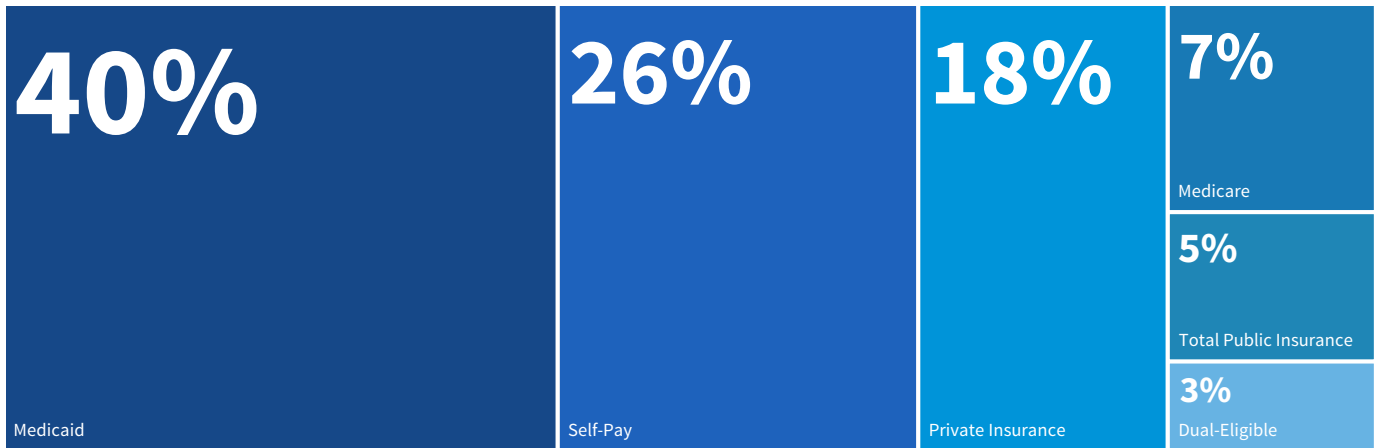
