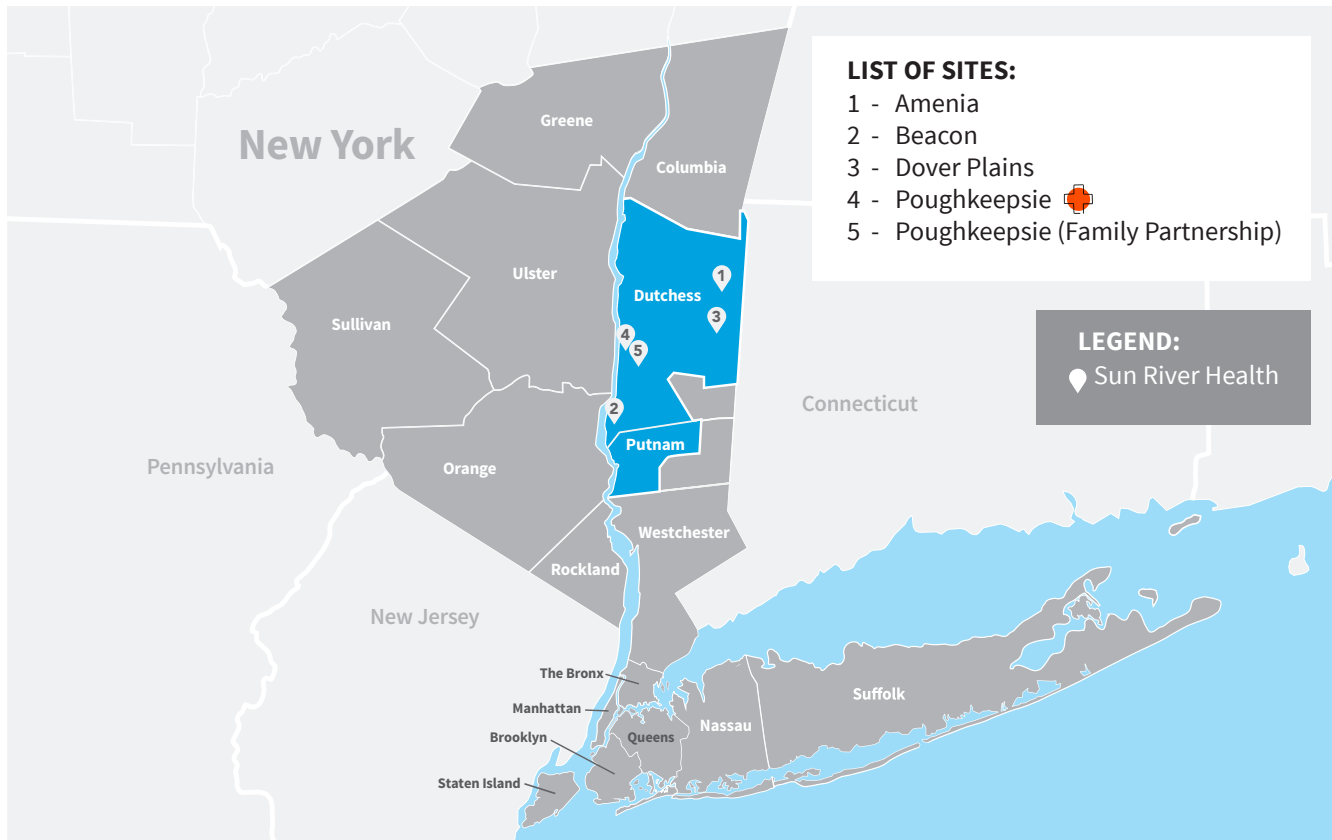

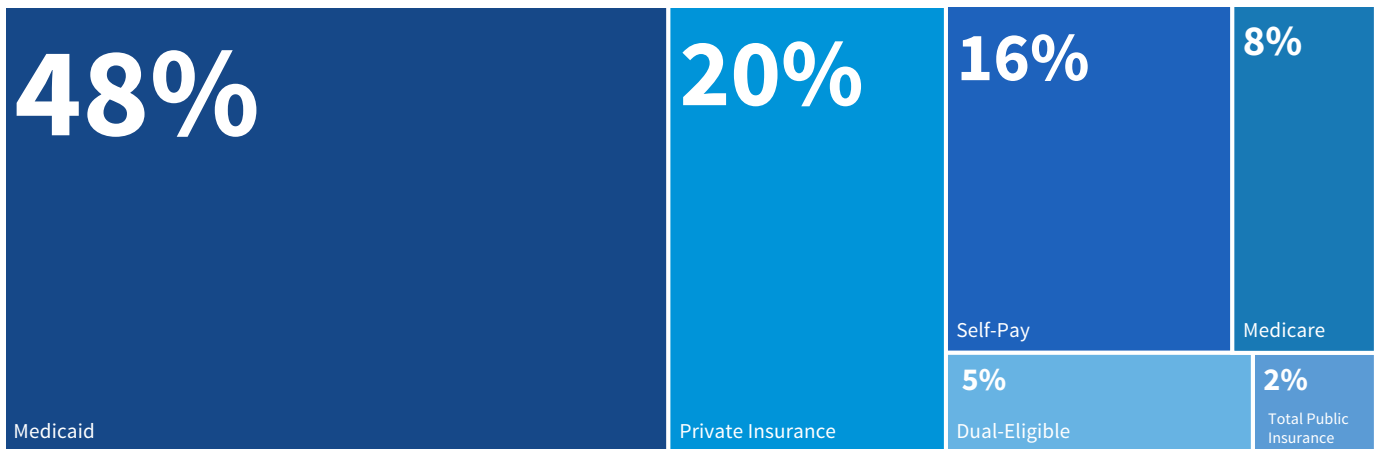

- We participate in the **NIH, All of Us Precision Medicine Research Program**, to diversify biomedical research nationwide
- Sun River Health Middletown is a unique model, where our primary care services are embedded within a behavioral health setting at ACCESS: Supports for Living
- Our Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program at the Poughkeepsie Family Partnership, is the largest of our network
- Our **community garden** at Sun River Health Amenia continues to flourish
- We support the **Dover School District Dental Program** at Amenia and expanded dental sealant program at Wingdale Elementary school, in collaboration with the Dover Union Free School District
