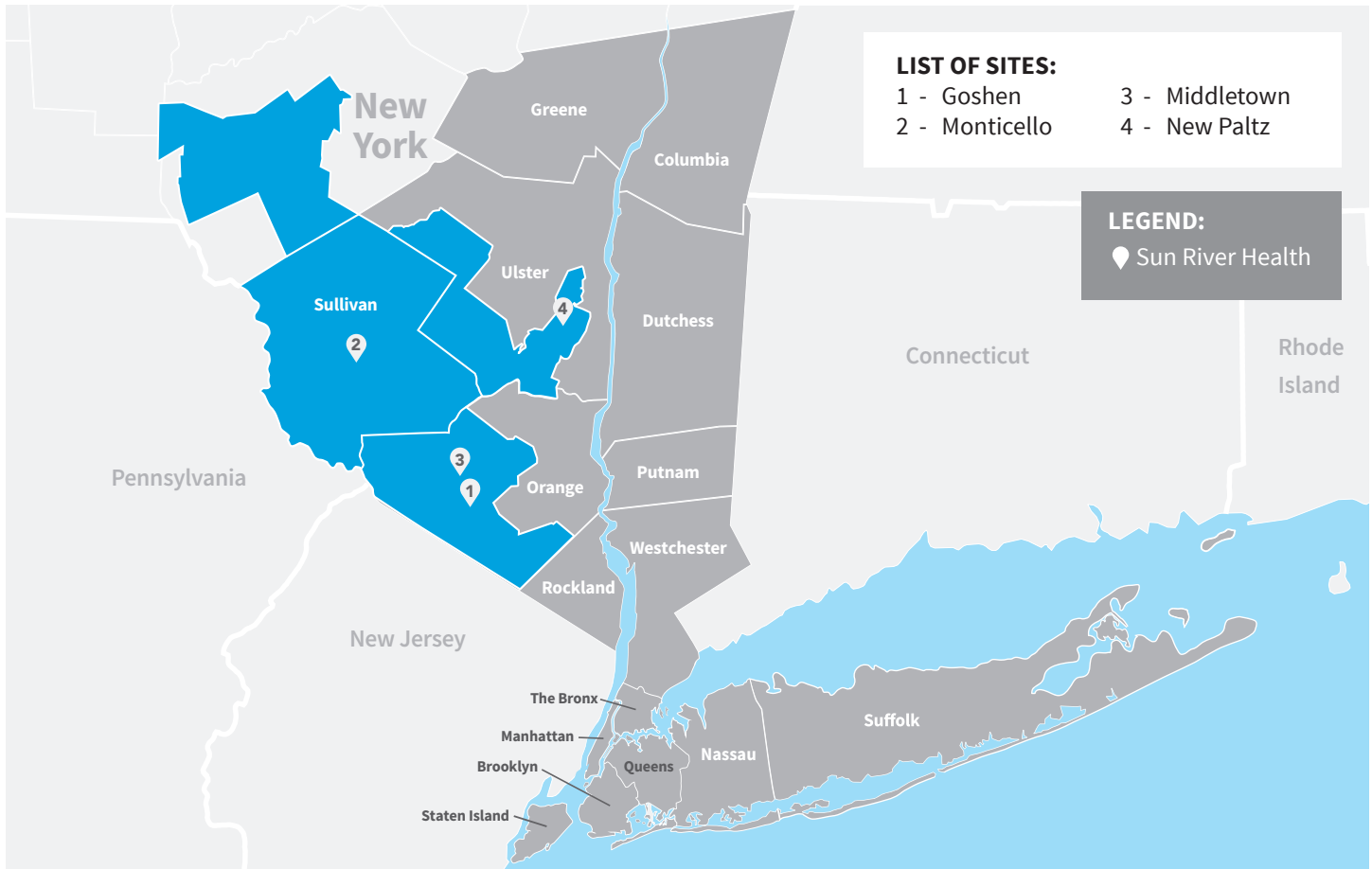

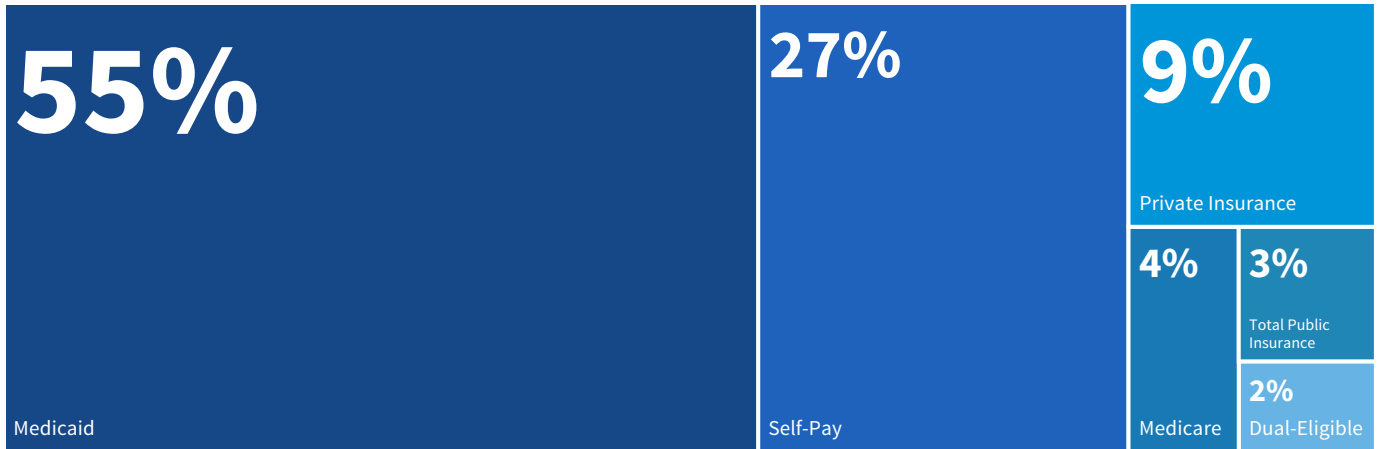

The Alamo Community Center

The Alamo Community Center, adjacent to the Sun River Health Alamo health center in Goshen, has been a hub of social support for agricultural workers and their families for decades. Over 3,600 individuals rely on services and support from The Alamo annually.

The Alamo Community Center’s food pantry provides food for over 250 households annually and delivers more than 40 hot meals to at-risk agricultural worker families every Sunday. Staff and community volunteers provide after school tutoring for about 30 children, a literacy program

for adults, exercise classes, teen pregnancy support, and other important programming. The Alamo supports a youth summer program with over 80 participants and two weekly empowerment groups for girls ages 9-12 and 13-17 from agricultural worker families.

Sun River Health’s outreach staff regularly visit agricultural worker housing to present Salud Para Todos, a drug and alcohol abuse awareness program. Representatives from the New York State Department of Labor are also available to assist agricultural workers with fair employment matters.
