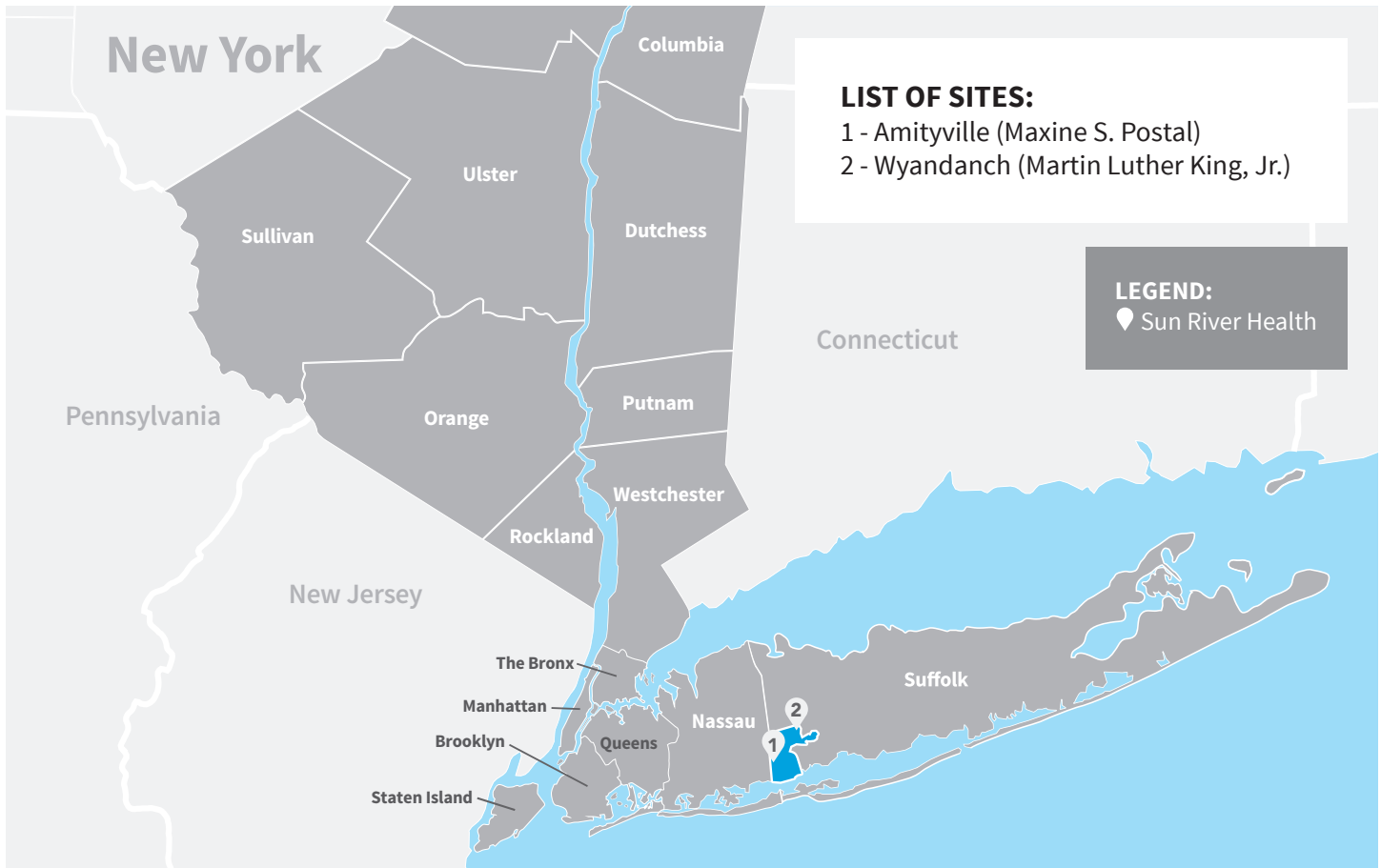

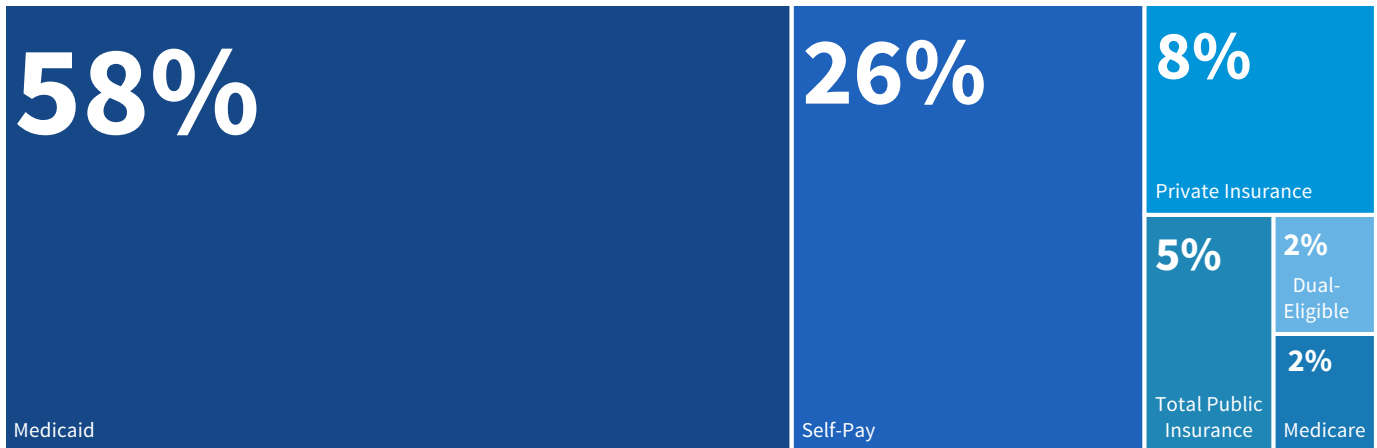

## More About Us

- Our close relationship with Suffolk County has enabled us to work hand in hand to find solutions for our patients, such as **providing public transit access** to local health centers
- In addition to our typical high-quality healthcare, we offer additional supportive services to **agricultural workers in the region**, such as **transportation, care coordination, and interpretation**. We retain access to this community through relationships we've built with farmworkers themselves, local growers and community organizations such as the **Long Island Farm Bureau**
- We are co-located in Amityville with our Medicaid Health Home Team. Sun River Health operates the largest Medicaid Health Home in New York State, serving **over 18,000 Medicaid members**, children and adults, with serious mental illness and other chronic conditions. By engaging and stabilizing the highest need Medicaid members, our network **creates cost-savings** for NYS and healthcare payers, while teaching patients to **effectively manage their own care**, and connecting them to appropriate supportive services that address their complex situations. Since 2015, our Health Home program has decreased mental health hospitalization by **3% per year**, decreased substance use hospitalization by **8% per year**.
