More About Us

- Patients benefit from the ease of utilizing our **in-house pharmacy**
- Our **340B program** provides patients with critical medications at low-to-no cost, including HIV medications and Suboxone
- Implemented Project SUCCEED, with the NYC Department of Health Viral Hepatitis Division to identify HIV/HCV positive patients and link them with care resulting in 68% of patients with hep C having an undetectable viral load
- We are one of six **HIV Undetectables Programs** in NYC with **200 patients enrolled**, all of whom have achieved an over 90% viral load suppression rate
- We operate an expanded **Adult Day Health Care** program
- Our Special Project of National Significance (SPNS) serves as a resource for other health centers interested in replicating our model of primary and behavioral health integration
- Our successful **TransHealth advocacy and support program** offers education and pre/post operative support for transgender individuals

About the Health Home program

- Sun River Health operates the largest Medicaid Health Home in New York State, serving over **18,000 Medicaid members**, children and adults, with serious mental illness and other chronic conditions. By engaging and stabilizing the highest need Medicaid members, our network **creates cost-savings** for NYS and healthcare payers, while teaching patients to **effectively manage their own care**, and connecting them to appropriate supportive services that address their complex situations. Since 2015, our Health Home program has decreased mental health hospitalization by **3% per year**, decreased substance use hospitalization by **8% per year**.

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
