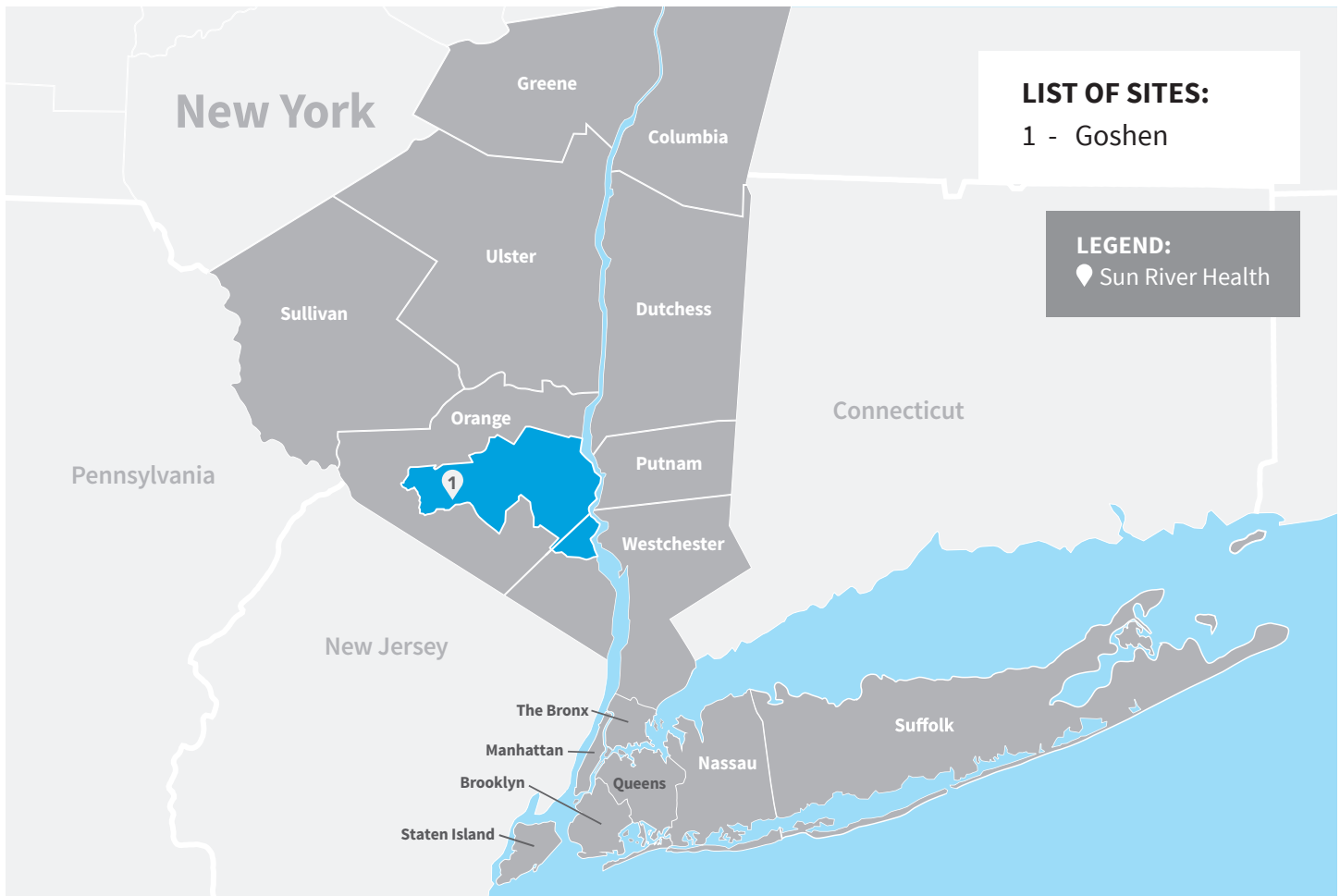

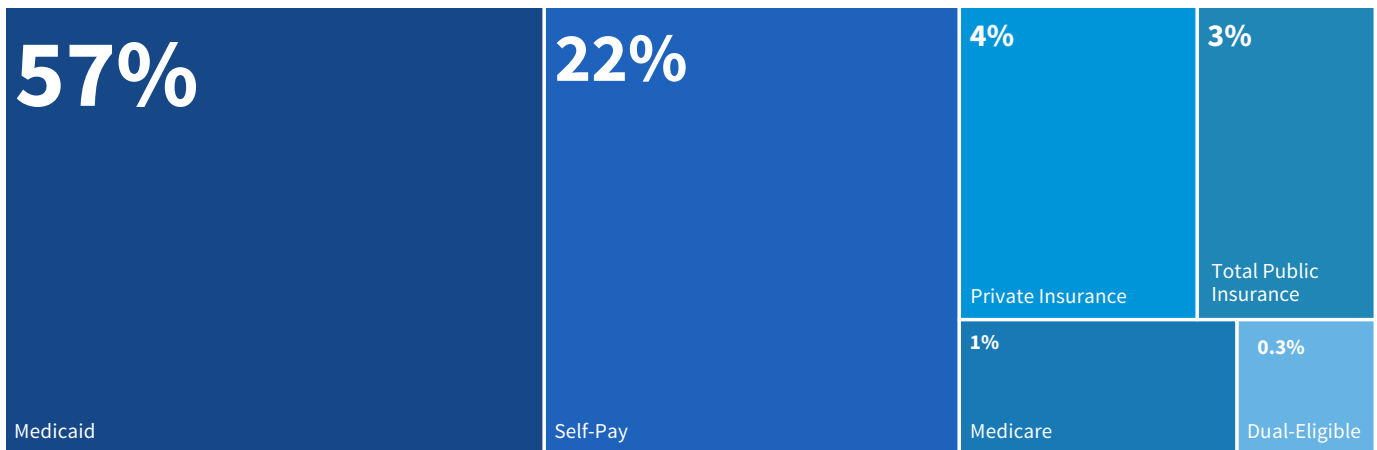

## About The Alamo

- The Alamo Community Center, adjacent to the Sun River Health Alamo health center in Goshen, has been a hub of social support for agricultural workers and their families for decades. Over 3,600 individuals rely on services and support from The Alamo annually.
- The Alamo Community Center’s food pantry provides food for over 250 households annually and delivers more than 40 hot meals to at-risk agricultural worker families every Sunday. Staff and community volunteers provide after school tutoring for about 30 children, a literacy program for adults, exercise classes, teen pregnancy support, and other important programming. The Alamo supports a youth summer program with over 80 participants and two weekly empowerment groups for girls ages 9-12 and 13-17 from agricultural worker families.
- Sun River Health’s outreach staff regularly visit agricultural worker housing to present Salud Para Todos, a drug and alcohol abuse awareness program. Representatives from the New York State Department of Labor are also available to assist agricultural workers with fair employment matters.
